

SFI – Swedish for Immigrants Komvux – Adult Education

- Do you speak a little Swedish or no Swedish at all?
- Do you find it difficult to write Swedish?
- Do you want to learn more Swedish?

SFI is elementary education in Swedish as a second language. You also learn about Swedish culture and society. SFI is intended for you, who have another native tongue than Swedish. To take part of the education, you must have a work permit and a residence permit for at least one year. You can start studying even if you have lived in Sweden for a reasonable length of time.

We normally admit new students four times a year. After an introduction of three weeks, you will be placed in a class, depending on your previous knowledge and your future goals.

Curriculum

SFI follows a national curriculum which includes the courses A, B, C and D. Which courses you will take depends on your educational background and your own goals.

The purpose of all the courses is to learn enough Swedish for communication in everyday life, education and working life.

Once you have fulfilled the requirements for SFI, you will get a certificate. The requirements include being an active participant during lessons, tests and other activities.

Lessons

The lessons are during the day all the year round, with a break for summer holidays. SFI is a fulltime education in which work practice and homework are included. Computers are used in the learning process. In some cases SFI can be combined with other courses within Komvux.
